# European Asian Economic Relations

The "**Master of Science in Economics and Management**" with Major "**European Asian Economic Relations**" at the Leibniz Universität Hannover offers a unique opportunity for intercultural learning and exchange among participants coming especially from Asia, Germany and other European countries. The programme is open for BSc graduates of economics and related subjects (e. g. agricultural economics, international development, management). It is envisaged to prepare for high-level positions in private and public sector organisations that deal with the economic relations between European and Asian countries. The Master programme offers a range of courses that will equip students with theoretical and empirical methods and practical tools to implement strategies which foster economic relations for business and international development.

The Master programme can be completed in one year, if the applicant has a four years Bachelor degree in economics.

The Master programme will take two years, if the applicant has a three years Bachelor degree in economics or related fields (e.g. development studies, agricultural economics, natural resources management).

Upon successful completion of the programme, the graduates will receive the degree "**Master of Science in Economics and Management**" with Major "**European Asian Economic Relations**".
